This Committee is chaired by Georgia Child Support Commission member, Dr. Roger C. Tutterow. The purpose of this meeting is to prepare for a formal economic study of the child support guidelines statute, O.C.G.A. § 19-6-15, and the Basic Child Support Obligation (BCSO) table, in the year 2022. Preparation for the 2022 economic study will include planning of “listening sessions” devoted to taking public comments on this topic, determining the process for case sampling of court orders and child support worksheets to be reviewed during the formal economic study, and to consider independent economists one of whom will be approved by the Child Support Commission and retained to conduct the economic study.
