Kathleen Connell, Esq., who is a member of the Georgia Commission on Child Support, chairs the Parenting Time Deviation Study Committee. This Study Committee consists of 28 members made up of attorneys, judges, staff of the Division of Child Support Services (DCSS), Legal Aid attorneys, and members of the public.

The purpose of this meeting is to continue discussions on the current parenting time deviation in Georgia's Child Support Guidelines statute, O.C.G.A. 19-6-15(g) and O.C.G.A. 19-6-15(i)(2)(K), and whether the Child Support Commission should recommend a change to the deviation in legislation to be considered at a future time by the Georgia General Assembly. This study committee was initiated by the Child Support Commission in November 2018 for a two-year period and has been extended for another 12 months to December 2021.
