10	Determine Georgia Counties to be Included in Case sampling	Dr. Tutterow will determine algorithm for use with the 2022 case sampling, including DCSS cases with pay summaries; may include conversation with economist.	
11	Organize Case Sampling Spreadsheet	Organize the case sampling spreadsheet for ease of use and collecting data for the study. Retain existing data elements, and make certain we capture LID, Imputed Income and, Default orders, among other items in 45 CFR 302.56. We also need to collect payment info. Determine if any new data elements need to be added or if there are data elements that can be removed.	

12	Clerk's Letter, Private Cases	Draft a letter to the 12 clerks for Judge Key's signature that will be mailed to the clerk's asking for their cooperation in gathering orders/WS for case sampling, and will include a due date for the return of the orders/WS. 18	Legislation	If the Commission votes to change the table, we will need a bill for the 2023 legislative session.		

19	Calculator	If the table changes and a bill is passed by the 2023 legislature, we will coordinate the update of the table in the calculator with vendor. May require separate contract for this work - review contract scope.
