

**Georgia Child Support Commission
Technology and Calculator Subcommittee

Meeting Summary

The Technology and Calculator Subcommittee of the Georgia Child Support Commission held a hybrid meeting on Friday, September 12, 2025, via Zoom Webinar and in person. Four (4) Subcommittee members attended. The Subcommittee members in attendance were:

Program Manager Kurt Bryan, Staff Attorney JoAnna Deering, and Project Coordinator Lazaro Quintanilla served as staff for this meeting.

Chair Quick opened the meeting at approximately 2:00 p.m., welcoming all attendees. Introductions were made of those attending online. A quorum of four (4) of the five (5) Subcommittee members was established. Additionally, Child Support Commission member Leader Chuck Efstration, Legislative Counsel Holly Carter, and a member of the public were present at the meeting. Chair Quick asked Lazaro to deliver the rules for the meeting. The previous Technology and Calculator Subcommittee meeting was held on July 18, 2025. The minutes were previously distributed to all subcommittee members. With no correction being made, the minutes were unanimously approved.

Kurt Bryan provided an update on the child support calculator Modernization Project. The modernized calculator was successfully deployed on July 21, 2025. Despite a minor issue pertaining to the two-step verification process, the application launched with no major reports of functionality loss. There are two minor issues on which IT is currently working. The first is the OTP verification code. IT is working on an implantation of a “remember me” feature that will allow a user to log in for a 30-day period before it is necessary to obtain another OTP verification code. The second is the removal the OTP verification code resend timer.

Kurt Bryan also spoke to the implementation of Senate Bill 454 which goes into effect on January 1, 2026. The two forthcoming additions to the Child Support Calculator are the Parenting Time Adjustment and the Low-Income Adjustment. Judge Davis requested that staff prepare a listing of the most common standard parenting plans with the number of parenting time days associated with each that can be used in lieu of making manual calculations using a calendar. Kurt noted that such a worksheet has already been created by Child Support Commission member Katie Connell, and it will be distributed to all Child Support Commission members for their input and feedback. Judge Davis further suggested that it would be beneficial for judges and family law practitioners to access training materials about the upcoming legislative changes and requested that staff create such training for users of the calculator. Chair Quick requested that staff obtain from IT a timeline for implementation of the Senate Bill 454 changes because it is very important

to test the changes well in advance of the effective statute date of January 1, 2026. Commission staff must have adequate time to test the changes and present them to Commission members for feedback. Kurt Bryan advised that he will coordinate with the JC/AOC's IT department to obtain a definitive timeline of when the changes will be uploaded to the testing environment. He will then report back to the Subcommittee so that the next meeting date can be established.

As for new business, Kurt Bryan presented a cost analysis report provided by AOC IT to address the deletion of worksheets. The report highlighted the financial costs of server and data maintenance and recommended options for saving on these costs. One of the options is to delete worksheets five years or older. Chair Quick requested that a member of IT go over the analysis report with the Subcommittee members so that they can better understand the recommendations and engage in further discussion. The Subcommittee unanimously approved a motion to recommend to the Commission that worksheets older than five years be archived.

Chair Quick will coordinate with Kurt to schedule the next Subcommittee meeting. The meeting adjourned at 2:27 p.m.
